NOTE: Weight must not exceed 25,000 lbs. per axle

**NOTE: Extra-Ordinary permits are single trip only and good for 48 Hours

PILOT CARS:

One certified pilot car in front required for loads between 8 ft. 6 inches and 11 ft. wide. One certified pilot car in front and one certified pilot car in back for loads 11 ft. to 16 ft. wide.

Extra-Ordinary Use Permit is required for all loads exceeding the maximum (see table above). Each Extra-Ordinary Use Permit requires individual consideration and a minimum of one full working day to process.

Extra-Ordinary loads may not travel before sunrise or after sunset without specific approval from the Road & Bridge Director or his designated representative.

Travel restrictions also apply for loads exceeding twelve feet (12') during school bus travel hours on most roads. If you anticipate traveling during these times, please contact Rudy Bevan at 970.250.5311 to verify specific times.

Over 200,000 lbs requires a \$150,000 Bond to operate on Mesa County Roads and Bridges.

Applicant is responsible for verification of all height restrictions.
