2027 “I Voted” Sticker Contest



WHO: Any young person, grades 1 through 12, who is a resident of Mesa County can participate. Winners will be chosen from the elementary, middle, and high school levels.

WHAT: Design an original logo that will be used to create 2-inch “I Voted” stickers and digital graphics for sharing throughout the 2027 election season.

Design Requirements:

- The words “I Voted” must appear somewhere in the design.
- The design must be original artwork created by the entrant.
- AI-generated artwork will not be accepted.

Winners will receive a \$50 gift card, a plaque featuring their artwork, and recognition at a County Commissioner meeting.

WHEN: Artwork will be collected between the period of September 8, 2026 through November 1, 2026. The Mesa County Elections office will select the top designs and then we will post those designs and open the contest up for voting on our website. Visit vote.mesacounty.us from December 1, 2026 through December 14, 2026 to vote for your favorite designs. The winning artwork will be announced in January of 2027. Stickers will be distributed during the 2027 election season.

Mesa County Elections 2027 “I Voted” Sticker Contest Rules

- All entrants must be in grades 1-12 and enrolled in a Mesa County public school, charter school, private school, or home school program
- Winners will be chosen from elementary (grades 1-5), middle school (grades 6-8), and high school (grades 9-12)
- Only one entry per student
- The phrase “I Voted” must be included in the design
- All entries must consist entirely of the student’s original, non-copyright artwork and may not include photos or trademarked images. No AI-generated artwork will be accepted
- Artwork must be nonpartisan and not reference any candidate, political party, or political issue
- Artwork that contains offensive language, violence, drugs, gangs, weaponry, etc. will not be considered
- Entries may be hand drawn or digitally designed
 - Hand-drawn entries must use the attached template
 - Digital files must be under 1 GB and must be a .pdf, .png, .jpg, or .jpeg
- By entering the contest, the student is allowing Mesa County Elections to use, reproduce, edit, or publish in any medium or media, their submission in whole or in part, for any non-commercial purpose in perpetuity
- The attached release form must be signed by a parent/guardian and submitted with your artwork
- **All entries must be received by November 1, 2026**
