

DOLA Launches New Housing Funding Directory, Expanding Digital Services for Coloradans

DOLA has launched the new [Division of Housing Funding Directory](#), a centralized, searchable resource designed to help nonprofit organizations, housing authorities, developers, local governments, and other community partners quickly identify funding programs that support housing initiatives across Colorado.

Users can quickly filter opportunities based on funding source and/or project type to find programs that best meet their needs.

Previously, users had to search through several sections of the website to locate available funding programs. By offering a single, user-friendly resource that enables organizations to spend less time seeking and more time providing housing solutions to their communities, the new directory simplifies that process.

The directory includes funding opportunities that support:

- Affordable housing development and preservation
- Homeownership initiatives
- Rental assistance
- Homelessness prevention and supportive housing
- Community development
- Neighborhood stabilization
- Low-interest financing for housing projects

The launch of the Funding Directory is one of many improvements DOLA has made to its digital presence over the past three years to prioritize accessibility, usability, and transparency. By expanding from a single website into multiple division-specific sites, the department has created clearer navigation that helps visitors locate information more efficiently.

This effort also includes a dedicated focus on accessibility, with approximately 96% of legacy documents now remediated and many PDF files converted into accessible web pages, improving the experience for users on mobile devices and those using assistive technologies.
